**Description Of Work:**

Hardwood (red oak) floor in dining room, living room, & hallway was cleaned, sealed, & top coated after we had removed aging carpet. N-Hance started their process by vacuuming baseboards, window sills, etc, to reduce the possibility of dust settling on the wet finish since fans would be used to help the drying between coats. Next the floor was cleaned & abraded using a buffer & liquid product (the corners were done manually), a coat of sealer was applied, some color correction was done on worn spots & new wood, & two coats of water-based polyurethane applied. Prior to N-Hance's arrival we replaced a few damaged strips of wood, filled the nail holes from the tack-less strip, set protruding nail heads, & cleared out the furniture. We are very pleased with the results (carpet pad markings & worn spots are gone). We are glad we did not have the floors refinished (sanded).

Our experience with N-Hance was pleasant & professional. We met Kurt Nangel of N-Hance when he was working on a neighbor's wood cabinets. He came over immediately, looked at our floors, went over the process, explained how long we would need to stay off the floors afterward, & gave us an estimate that was good for 60 days. He also gave us a recommendation of someone who could replace some damaged wood strips. After arranging to have wood strips replaced, I called to schedule the work. Crew arrive promptly at 8 am as planned & went to work. They were done by 3 pm & we were able to walk on the floor in stocking feet a couple of hours later. N-Hance gave us clear instructions about moving furniture & floor covering back (best to wait 3 days), & routine maintenance. All phone calls were returned promptly & the work area was left as found. We are very happy.
